Also, now is the time to send in appropriate outdoor wear — mittens, hats, snowpants, boots and warm winter coats are needed for playing outside, especially on snowy days!


Please label <u>all</u> of your child's clothing, especially the outer wear. It's easy to mix up and lose little mittens, hats, coats, boots and snowpants.
