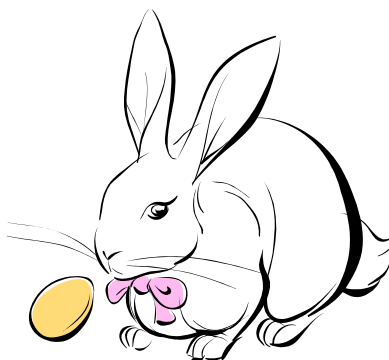

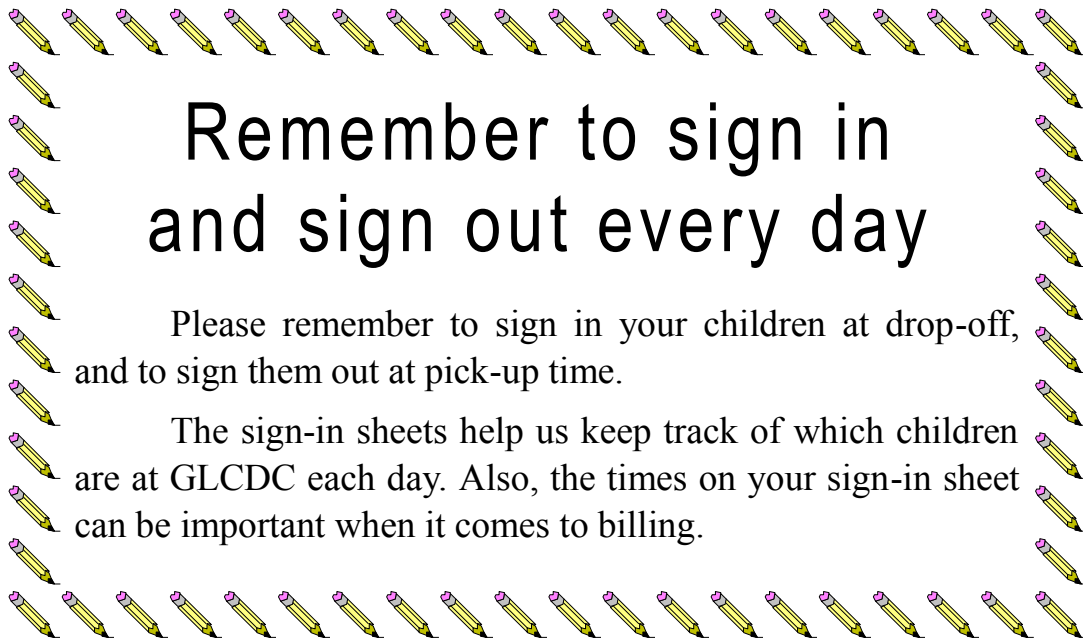

teaches us a good lesson.

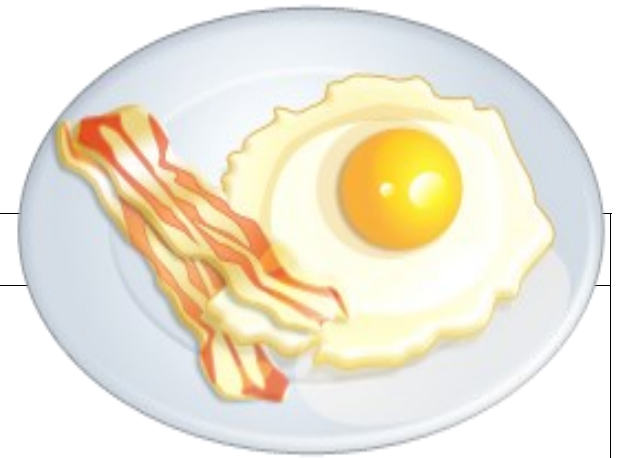
