## **New Fees for 2024**



Our new school year officially starts on Monday, Sept. 9th. As announced in August, our daily fee will be increasing by \$3 per day for the weekly cost and \$10 a

day for the daily cost. This rate increase takes effect on Monday, Sept. 9th, and will be reflected in your new fee contract. Parents will be asked to sign a new contract fee.

Beginning on Sept. 9th you will be charged for every day listed on your child's fee contract. Billing statements will be based on the fee contracts. If your child does not attend on a scheduled day, you will still be charged for that day. It will be your responsibility to fill in earned vacation days ahead of a planned absence. If you do not have earned vacation days, you will be charged for a scheduled day even if your child is sick on that day. Fiscal year runs from September through August.

Please let us know 2 weeks in advance for vacation days. We understand things happen and you may have to give short notice.
