11:00-12:00 - Lunch (using individual feeding plans)

3:00-3:30 - Afternoon Snack Time

5:30 – Center Closes

In the infant room we follow each child's individual feeding and sleeping plans. Diapers are given every two hours unless needed before the two-hour mark. Throughout the day, children engage in developmentally appropriate activities including fine motor, gross motor, audio, and visual stimulation.
